Home Workers Get Naked

KISSIMMEE, Fla. (April 10, 2006) -- A growing trend among businesses is the option for employees to work from home. A survey conducted by SonicWALL, Inc., a provider of network security, indicated 76 percent of employees surveyed believed working remotely enhanced productivity. Respondents also felt their managers would agree.

All respondents felt that a benefit of working from home was that it allowed them to work in a more relaxed environment and maintain a more flexible schedule. So it comes as no surprise some workers wear nothing at all. Out of 941 workers surveyed, twelve percent of males and seven percent of females reveal that they work in the nude.
