- Eric Schuttauf announced the latest club to earn its charter status, Southwest Nude Runners Travel Club presented to Ted Peck.

- Mike Parker mentioned that he didn't like the Wreaths Across America as a disabled veteran. He also mentioned that he had friends who were non-Christians wouldn't have anything to do this this program.

MARNA travel club statement

The following statement, sent by a representative of the MARNA travel club was read by Ronna Krozy, AANR PR Chair. The intent of this statement was an appeal for "good citizenship" among individuals when talking about other nudist clubs. The statement was edited for clarity.

"Maryland Area Naturist Association, now a robust Travel Club of AANR EAST is in their 29th year of operation holding swims and Nude Yoga at rented indoor and outdoor locations across Maryland and South-Central Pennsylvania. We are thrilled and honored to have won the Falconer award for club growth FOUR times since 2013. The Club was conceived first in 1980 when 18-year-old Maryland native Walter Green III enlisted in the U.S. Army and having been stationed in Germany discovered Nudism and brought the concept home to his Community.

By 1995 the MARNA website was born and events were held soon after. The secret, how we outlasted every single non-landed [club] in the Mid-Atlantic states who hosted such swims, [is that] We are truly a community of friends and extended family. And we have assembled a membership group largely of the age bracket of 20's to mid-fifties, though of course ALL ARE WELCOME as space allows.

On that note, we are aware that some other clubs [who] are evolving in an era when many post COVID are struggling internally with management, finances or in some cases, exiting AANR or ceasing to function as Nudist. [This has created some attempts to unjustly disparage clubs to recruit new members into other clubs. However] we want to encourage ALL clubs to be positive and instruct all members to speak positively of all other clubs. This is not difficult to accomplish if we all try.

We have always strived to be a family friendly and even-gendered group and [once] attended come as guests and leave their first event as friends and always return. Yes, some may find travel clubs breaking such new ground and in some cases holding more events monthly than a few [landed clubs] surprising. We do not; and [we] are always striving to try new things.
